Dear Golden Racquets (GR) Members:

The signup process for next season has begun! Please visit the GR website (www.goldenracquets.org) to view and get the signup form. All signup forms must be received by email no later than Friday, August 12, 2022.

Two important members of GR Board of Directors (Gary Henson, our Vice President and Steve Mateo, our Chairman of the Rating Committee), have informed me that they must resign. Later in this newsletter Gary shares his reason for leaving. He has captained venues with a wide variety of levels of tennis players, and has been instrumental in running and helping our pickleball



program grow to four venues with 32 regular players. He was an ideal instructor for members just learning to play pickleball. Gary's easy-going nature helped him make many friends within GR. The GR Board of Directors will appoint an Acting Vice President, and in October the membership will vote on filling the position for a term of two years.

Steve Mateo needed to resign from his position as chairman of the Rating's Committee due to health reasons. He began his service to GR as our Social Director and then moved to the Rating Committee. As a member of that committee and for more than four years, he did the bulk of the rating reviews of new and current members. During that time, he was voted "Player of the Year." He subsequently moved into the position of Chairman, which he has held for more than three years. He developed a rating system to better evaluate the many skills needed to play tennis at different levels. Steve's goal now is to start playing tennis again in October or November. I will be the Acting Chairman of the Rating's Committee until a person can be appointed to fill the position.

Pete Koenig, a former GR President, will assume the responsibilities of overseeing the pickleball program for GR. This fall, there will be three outdoor pickleball venues, and they will be located at Wakefield Park, Roundtree Park, and Rolling Valley Park. When those venues end in November, GR hopes to find an indoor facility where those players can continue to play for the rest of the season. Burke Racquet and Swim Club will again provide two indoor courts for pickleball that will go from September through May.



Fairfax County Golden Racquets Membership Demographics: July 2022




Golden Racquets Tennis Club is currently 373 members strong. Demographic information of GR membership was collected from the GR central database and analyzed by Dr. Catherine Ngo-Wilde. The following table and charts present a summary of members' residential locations, ages, and GR ratings.

Figure 1 shows the number of members living in various cities throughout Fairfax County and surrounding regions. Most residences are concentrated in Fairfax, Falls Church, Alexandria, Arlington, Annandale, Springfield, and Vienna (in descending order).

Figure 1 shows the age distribution of members, grouped into age brackets. Collectively, a large majority of nembers are between the ages of 65 - 79 years, with an average age of 73.9 years.

Figure 2. Distribution of GR ratings






Figure 3. Count of Members in Each Rating Group

Collectively, a majority of members are rated between 3.7 - 3.9, with the largest rating group a 3.8.
